Florida Restaurant and Lodging Association to Distribute 50,000 Masks to First Coast Hospitality Workers

JACKSONVILLE – Beginning Monday, September 14, through Wednesday, September 16, the Florida Restaurant and Lodging Association (FRLA) Northeast Chapter will distribute 50,000 complimentary washable, reusable cloth masks to local hospitality employees at regional giveaway events.

The event is part of an ongoing statewide effort to provide masks to bar, hotel, and restaurant workers across the State of Florida and is a joint initiative of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and the Florida Restaurant and Lodging Association. To date, HHS has donated nearly **one million masks** for distribution to hospitality employees across Florida.
