

## WEEKLY DUVAL COUNTY STR REPORT 10.10.21

#### **SUMMARY:**

The week of October 10<sup>th</sup> saw Occupancy at 74%, a gain of nearly 30% over the prior year. This is a small growth over last week as well. Friday and Saturday nights continue to show the highest Occupancy statistics. More rooms were sold in this week of 2021 than in same week in the past three years. Average Rate was over \$100. Room Revenue was \$9.6 million. All areas saw double digit RevPAR Growth as well as growth in Occupancy and ADR over last year.

Month to Date Occupancy is 73% and ADR is approximately \$101. Room Revenue is \$21.8 million. ADR is up about \$4 from 2018 and 2019 with the same Occupancy percentage and about \$22 higher than 2020.

## WEEKLY DUVAL COUNTY STR REPORT 10.17.21

#### **SUMMARY:**

Occupancy for the week of October 17<sup>th</sup> was nearly 70%, which is very similar to the occupancy levels we saw in 2019. Friday and Saturday continue to maintain the highest occupancy and average rate for the week. This same week in 2018 hosted the Florida vs. Georgia football game on that Saturday and about 7,500 more rooms were sold during that week as a result. All areas of town saw double digit RevPAR growth. Northside/Airport saw the largest percentage of growth.

Month-to-Date occupancy is nearly 72% with and ADR of \$100.17. Room revenue to date for the month is \$30.8 million. It was \$34.6 million in 2018 including the Florida vs. Georgia room revenue, which we have yet to see for 2021.
