

WEEKLY DUVAL COUNTY STR REPORT 11.8.20

SUMMARY:

Duval County posted Occupancy at 56.3% for the week of November 8th. This was a slight drop from the prior week, but the Occupancy drop is likely from the Florida vs. Georgia Football Weekend. Room Revenue was almost \$5.5 million. These statistics are much like the past few months average minus the Florida vs. Georgia Weekend. Duval County is seeing about 20,000 less rooms sold each week compared to 2019 statistics.

The Arlington hotels saw the lowest losses in Occupancy and RevPAR this week, followed by the Westside hotels and the Beaches. Downtown saw the largest loss in Occupancy at nearly 50% less than the same time in 2019.

Month-to-Date, Occupancy is at 57.1% which is nearly 27% less than November 2019's Month-to-Date statistics. Average Rate is more than \$30 lower than the prior year's statistics.
