

WEEKLY DUVAL COUNTY STR REPORT 3.29.20

SUMMARY:

As COVID-19 cancellations, closures and mandates continued, Duval County hotels have seen substantial losses in all STR Measurements. Occupancy fell to under 30%, a loss of nearly 63% when comparing to same week last year. Room Revenue was down \$7.7 Million when comparing to same time last year. Average Rate ran under \$65 for the county; rates this low have not been common since 2010-2011 during some of the traditionally slow months like December.

Remembering that the first two weeks of March were operating near normal, Occupancy Month-to-Date is approximately 56%, a loss of 34.6%. Average Rate for the month has seen a loss of more than \$15 and Room Revenue has seen a loss of more than \$22 million dollars in March.
