

## WEEKLY DUVAL COUNTY STR REPORT 9.27.20

## **SUMMARY:**

The previous week in Duval County saw Occupancy at 53.8%, a loss of 20.2% for the same time last year. Room Revenue is showing down 32.6%, a \$2.2 million loss in revenue, when comparing to same week in 2019. All areas of our county are continuing to feel the impacts of COVID-19 cancellations, reduced capacities and suppressed travel demand. Westside hotels continue to see the least amount of losses in Revenue Per Available Room and Downtown hotels continue to see the greatest losses in RevPAR.

Month to Date (all of September), Occupancy is at 57.0%, a loss of 14.3% when comparing to September 2019. Room Revenue is showing a loss of \$8.7 million when comparing to September 2019.
