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WEEKLY DUVAL COUNTY STR REPORT 9.29.19

SUMMARY:

This past week saw slight declines in all three STR Measurements. Overall, Occupancy was down just 1% with not all areas seeing a loss. Average Rate saw a half percentage point loss. RevPAR saw a 1.5% loss overall. Sunday night was the largest Occupancy loss and this was likely from not having a Jaguars home game in 2019, while in 2018 there was a home game against the Jets.

Month-to-date Occupancy was down 7.6%, which includes all of September. Average Rate is down 1.3%. With Hurricane Dorian's impacts felt strongly earlier in the month, it was going to be tough to recover.
